The top three societies are chosen from among Gold Merit Award societies. All societies entering will receive a *Find Fun In The Past... Build Joy In The Future!* Certificate of Participation. Awards are based upon the responses received on this form. **Affirmative answers will be verified**. Documentation of activities and programs **MUST** accompany this entry and will be considered in judging. Sufficient information **MUST** be provided in order to allow the chairman to properly evaluate your entry. For example, entries may be accompanied by newsletters, pertinent documents, and/or photo pages pertaining to a specific activity.

No separate photo albums are allowed. No videos, or media submissions are allowed. Entries are limited to <u>50</u> pages (excluding newsletters, yearbook, and copy of Treasurer's Report). Double-sided sheets count as two pages. Please number ALL pages and reference the page numbers on this form. Societies should return the completed form, (with required attachments), covering the period from March 1, 2022 to February 28, 2023.

Gold Merit Award All sections must be answered "Yes."

Blue Merit Award All but one section must be answered "Yes."

Red Merit Award All but two sections must be answered "Yes."

Honorable Mention Sections A and F must be answered "Yes."

Certificate of Participation All other entries will receive a certificate.
